Elephant Safari Itinerary March 19-31, 2001

With mobile camping, your camp goes where the wildlife does. As the wildebeest migration moves, so does your camp and staff, always ensuring the best possible game viewing while on safari.

Large, airy tents with king size double beds, white linen tablecloths and excellent service take you back in time to the safaris of the 1930s where no luxury was left behind and no effort spared to spoil you!

The safari finishes with a visit to the private game sanctuary and home of Lewa Downs, where you are wined and dined and introduced to luxurious life in the bush. A true safari adventure!

Monday March 19 – After an overnight flight from London, arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport on BA 2069 at 10.00. After clearing customs and immigration (visa can be obtained at the airport), you will be met by the Anne, your Eco-resorts representative. Transfer to Macushla House in the Langata area of Nairobi. Anne will check you into your room and will then go through your safari itinerary with you.

Spend the afternoon at your leisure, catching up on sleep or perhaps visiting the nearby Giraffe Manor. Dinner may be taken at Macushla House or elsewhere, depending upon your choice. Overnight at Macushla House.

Tuesday March 20 – After breakfast, your driver will collect you at 09.45 and transfer you to Wilson Airport to check-in for your Air Kenya flight to Kilimanjaro, departing at 11.45. Your air tickets will be at the check-in desk for you. (Please note that you must pay the US\$ 40 departure tax directly at this airport.)

Arrive at Kilimanjaro Airport at 12.45, clear immigration and customs and met by the Regional Air representative who will direct you to the short shuttle flight to Arusha, departing at 13.30, arriving at 13.45. Again, your tickets will be waiting for you at the check-in desk.

In Arusha your safari representative will meet you and direct you to the connecting flight to the Serengeti departing at 14.00. Arrive in the Serengeti at approximately 15.00. Met by your dedicated driver/guide and enjoy a game drive enroute to your luxury tented camp. Sundowners, dinner and overnight at the camp.

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Tuesday March 21 – Saturday 24 – Spend these four days exploring the vast expanse of this incredibly diverse and fascinating ecosystem. As well as watching for the “Big Five” animals of lion, leopard, elephant, rhino and buffalo, keep an eye out for wild dog, hyena, wildebeest, antelope, zebra, jackals, giraffe, hyrax, mongooses and the many wonderful birds that are found in this area. Enjoy delicious foods, friendly service and amazingly comfortable nights in your camp under the African stars. Celebrate with a champagne dinner on your last night in camp. Your days are spent as you wish; your driver/guide and vehicle are at your disposal.

Sunday March 25 – After breakfast, set off across country with your driver guide toward the Ngorongoro Crater. Stop off at the Olduvai Gorge along the way, where the Leakey’s found ancient man. Monday March 26 – Have breakfast at the lodge and then head down into the Crater again for a full day exploring this United Nations Biosphere. Enjoy a picnic lunch watching the abundant game before returning to the Crater rim and the Serena Lodge for dinner and overnight.

Tuesday March 27 – Have an early breakfast and then depart from the Crater on your way to Arusha. You will drive past Lake Manyara and the town of Mto wa Mbu as you drive down the escarpment. Arrive at the Arusha Airport for your Regional Air flight to Kilimanjaro, which departs at 12.30, arriving at 12.45. A boxed lunch will be provided to ward off hunger pangs!

At Kilimanjaro Airport you connect to the Air Kenya flight back to Wilson Airport, Nairobi, which departs at 13.30, arriving at 14.30. At Wilson, after clearing immigration, your driver will transfer you back to Macushla House. Spend the afternoon at leisure at Macushla House. Dinner as you choose and overnight at Macushla House.

Wednesday March 28 – Have an early breakfast before your driver collects you at 08.00 to transfer you to Wilson Airport for the Air Kenya flight to Nanyuki and Lewa Downs, departing at 09.15. Tickets at the check-in desk. Arrive at Lewa Downs at 10.20 where you are met by your vehicle and driver/guide. Enjoy a game drive through this wonderful private game reserve on the way to your cottage. Lunch at Lewa Downs and then spend the afternoon game walking through the savannah with your expert guide. Dinner and overnight at the cottages.

Thursday March 29 – Spend this full day exploring the Lewa Downs area, with its rhino, grevvy’s zebra, reticulated giraffe, elephant, buffalo, gerenuk, Sitatunga antelope and much more. The landscape here is stunningly beautiful and Mount Kenya, rising majestically in the distance, forms the background for many photos. All meals at Lewa Downs.

Friday March 30 – Enjoy breakfast at the cottages before a game drive enroute to the airstrip for your 11.00 departure on the Air Kenya flight to Wilson Airport and Nairobi. Arrive in Nairobi at approximately 12.15; the driver from Ngong House will meet you and transfer you to Ngong House. Spend the afternoon relaxing at Ngong House, in your tree house. Perhaps visit the Karen Blixen Museum or do some shopping at Utamuduni? Dinner and overnight at Ngong House.

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Saturday March 31 – After breakfast at Ngong House, explore Nairobi as you please with the Ngong House driver. Your entrance fees must be paid directly, but your transport is provided courtesy of Ngong House. Ngong House will transfer you to the Jomo Kenyatta Airport at 19.30 to check in for the BA 2068 flight to London, departing at 22.25.

Elephant Safari Itinerary December 4-17, 2000

This safari was designed for a young professional on a business trip to Nairobi. Combining her trip with a safari vacation with her mother, she explored several of the best game viewing areas in Kenya.

A delightful tented camp in Amboseli, famous for its elephant viewing, was followed by a brief driving safari through the magnificent Rift Valley and an overnight stay at Lake Nakuru, a wonderful small park famous for its leopard, lion and flamingo.

Night game viewing at the Ark in the Aberdares offered a chance for viewing animals, and a couple of nights in the private mobile camp of the Solio game sanctuary offered excellent rhino viewing and game walking opportunities.

Last, but certainly not least, a visit was paid to the famous Masai Mara and the famous Governor's Camp. One of the most famous areas in Kenya, the Mara is known for its big cat populations, buffalo, elephant, wildebeest migration and numerous birds.

This safari is a perfect trip for anyone wishing comfort while exploring the best of the wilderness areas.

Sunday December 3 - Arrive at the Nairobi international Airport on your KLM flight from Amsterdam. Met at the airport by the International Rescue Committee representative and taken to your Nairobi Hotel.

Monday December 4 - Collected by your IRC representative at your hotel at 06.30 am. Transfer to the domestic airport, Wilson Airport and your Air Kenya 7.30 am flight to Amboseli. Your tickets will be waiting for you at the Air Kenya check in desk. Arrive at approximately 08.15. Enjoy a game drive enroute to the Camp, lunch at the Camp and an afternoon game drive before dinner and overnight at the Camp.

Tuesday December 5 - A full day exploring the park, swamp and salt flats. Overnight at the camp.

Wednesday December 6 - After breakfast, an early departure to catch your 08.30 flight back to Nairobi, arriving at 09.15. Met and collected at the airport by the Eco-resorts driver and transferred to Lake Nakuru and the Lake Nakuru Lodge, about a two-three hour drive through the some of the best scenery in Kenya; the Rift Valley is just stunning! Game drive around Lake Nakuru and overnight at the Lodge.

Thursday December 7 - Breakfast at the Lodge before a leisurely drive back to Nairobi and drop off at the Hilton hotel by 12 noon. Attend IRC Course in Nairobi.

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Sunday December 10 - Your driver will collect you from the Hilton Hotel at 08.30am. Depart Nairobi enroute to the Aberdare Country Club. Enjoy lunch at the Club before your transfer to the Ark for overnight in this stunning forest lodge.

Wednesday December 13 – After breakfast, transfer to Nanyuki for the 10.00 flight to the Masai Mara. Tickets will be at the check in desk. Met and taken to the Little Governor's Camp. Game drives, dinner and overnight at Little Governor's camp.

Thursday December 14 – An early morning departure for your game walk in the adjoining reserve and your champagne bush breakfast. Game drive back to the camp for lunch. Game drive or relax in the afternoon before dinner and overnight at Little Governor's camp.

Friday December 15 – Game drives through the magnificent Masai Mara, exploring the diverse ecosystem and enjoying the abundant wildlife. Overnight at Little Governor's camp.

For the next three nights, explore this rich ecosystem on foot and in 4x4 vehicles with your expert, local guides. Visit local villages, track animals through the bush, enjoy sundowners on the hilltops and delicious dinners under the African sky. All activities and meals at Rekeru Camp.

Saturday March 31- April 1 - After breakfast, you will be taken to the airstrip to catch your private charter flight at 09.30 to the Laikipia region and the wonderful Borana Lodge. The flight will take approximately 1 hour and 20 minutes. Met at the Borana airstrip and taken to the Lodge. Spend the afternoon tracking rhino through the bush, or game driving over the arid plains. Your Eco-resorts representative, Melinda, will join you here to check on your safari's progress. All activities and meals at the Borana Lodge for two nights.

Monday April 2 – Wednesday 4 - After breakfast, game drive to the airstrip for your 11.30 flight to Amboseli, which will take approximately 1 hour. Arrive in Amboseli, met by the

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Rainey's and taken to the OI Kanjau tented camp for the next three nights. Nestled at the foot of Mount Kilimanjaro, OI Kanjau offers wonderful views of elephant, hyena, plains antelope and numerous birds. All activities and meals at OI Kanjau.

Thursday April 5 – Monday 9 - After breakfast, your private charter flight at 09.30 will take you to the Malindi Airport (approximately 1 hour) where the Hemingway's driver will meet you for your 20-minute transfer to Watamu. Melinda will meet you here to check on your comfort and to help with any requests you may have. Spend the next five nights at this delightful beach resort.

Tuesday April 10 - Depart Hemingway's at 12.45 to catch the 13.45 flight to Nairobi, arriving at 15.00. Your tickets will be waiting for you at the check-in counter. You will be met here by your driver/guide who will be at your disposal for the remainder of the day. Last minute shopping or visits to your favorite animals at the orphanage are all possible. He will take you to Macushla House where you may relax and shower before your transfer to the airport at 20.30 to check in for your departure flight at 23.45.

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The Loehr Family Safari Elephant Safari Itinerary December 17 – 31, 2000

Designed for a family with children ranging from 10-16 years old, who were visiting relatives in Kenya, this safari is for the active wildlife explorer. For part of the trip, some family members explored one area, while the other members explored another area, adding an unusual twist to their adventure.

Camel trek and mobile camp through the harsh beauty of the northern district, learning the art of survival in this desert-like area. Surprisingly rich in wildlife, you'll learn to track the movements of the game. Then swim in the warm waters of the Indian Ocean in search of angelfish, pipefish and other colorful species.

Oi Kanjau, a luxurious mobile camp in Amboseli is next, followed by the big cat territory of the Masai Mara and Rekeru. Privately hosted by the owners, these two camps offer excellent service and some of the best game viewing in Kenya.

Private charter flights ensure little time is wasted travelling, providing beautiful views over the African plains.

Sunday December 17-Arrive at 20.55 into Nairobi at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport. Met at the airport and transferred to Macushla House in the Langata suburb for the night. Accommodation and breakfast are included.

Saturday – Sunday December 23 – 24 - In Watamu, spend time around the swimming pool, snorkelling in the marine park, strolling on the beach, exploring Gede Ruins, the Arabuko-Sokoke Forest and the Mida Creek Mangrove Creek. Here you are free to do as much or as little as you wish while you enjoy Anne and Neel's hospitality.

Monday December 25 -One adult and three children depart from Malindi Airport at 12.30pm on the Boskovic charter flight to the Masai Mara and three nights at Rekeru Camp. You will

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arrive at approximately 14.30 at the Mara where you will be met and transferred to the Rehero Tented Camp for your Mara experience. Accommodation, all meals, all activities, all park fees, soft drinks, house wines and beers included.

Tuesday – Wednesday December 26 – 27 - In the Mara you will be introduced to the fascinating world of the Masai tribe, their traditions, cultures and their relationships with the animals, plants and flowers of the Mara savannah grasslands. You will enjoy village visits, game walks, botany walks, game drives, excellent camp cooked meals, friendly, helpful staff and a very comfortable tent accommodation.

Tuesday December 26 -Ashley and one parent fly from Malindi Airport at 13.45 on the scheduled Air Kenya flight to Nairobi, arriving at 15.00 and transferred to Macushla House for overnight. Accommodation, breakfast and airport transfers are included.

Wednesday December 27 -Ashley and parent explore Nairobi. Overnight at Macushla House. In Nairobi, you may travel around with your cousin Tommy, or Macushla House will arrange a taxi to be at your disposal throughout the day. (Extra charge.) The charter flight from the Mara leaves at 10.30am and will arrive at Amboseli at approximately 12.00 noon. Spend three nights at Ol Kanjau, Amboseli. Accommodation, all meals, soft drinks, house wines, beers, park fees and all activities included.

Friday – Saturday December 29-30 - At Ol Kanjau you will be introduced to the work of the many animal researchers in the area. Elephant, wild dog and hyena are just a few of the animal research projects currently under way in Amboseli. The Rainey's have worked with various researchers over their 25 years in Kenya and they are a veritable treasure trove of animal, bird and plant information, all of which they will pass onto you as you explore this well-known park.

Sunday December 31-At 16.00, your charter flight will collect you from Amboseli and return you to Nairobi, arriving at approximately 16.45. Your driver will meet you and will be at your disposal for the remainder of the afternoon and evening. An early dinner will be arranged for you before your departure to the International airport to check in at 21.00 for the departure at 23.35.

Thursday September 14 – Your driver will collect you from the Fairview Hotel in Nairobi at 09.30am. You'll enjoy a leisurely one and a half hour drive through the Great Rift Valley to the Mundui Estate on the edge of Lake Naivasha. This is a beautiful place to relax, recover from your business work during the previous two weeks and start your safari. Enjoy a game drive, gentle walks and the hospitality of Mundui. Overnight at Mundui Estate.

Friday September 15 – Enjoy wandering through the estate, spotting the wildlife and exploring the Hell's Gate National Park close to Lake Naivasha. Overnight at the Mundui Estate.

You will be collected at the airstrip and will then enjoy four wonderful nights at Rekeru exploring the wildlife, plants, and cultures of this wonderful part of the country. Sunday September 17 – With the company of the Beaton family and their Masai and Ndorobo tribesmen partners, you are able to game drive or game walk through the vast plains of the Masai Mara. Spend the day exploring this wonderful area and enjoying the rich variety of wildlife. Overnight at Rekeru.

Monday September 18 – Why not mix a cultural introduction with your wildlife today and let your hosts introduce you to the Masai tribe and their culture? Explore a Masai village and learn the ancient traditions still practiced by these people. Overnight at Rekeru.

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Tuesday September 19 – Spend your last day in the Mara on foot or in a 4x4 vehicle in search of any wildlife you may have missed in previous days. Or simply relax at Rekeru and watch the game at the waterhole from the comfort of your veranda. Overnight at Rekeru

Wednesday September 20 – A private charter flight from Rekeru to Kitich Camp in the Matthews Mountain Range. Here you spend three nights with your host, Giulio, exploring the forests and hills in this isolated and private area. There are very few roads in the Matthews Range and most of your exploring is performed on foot through the shady forest. Overnight at Kitich Camp.

Thursday September 21 – After a leisurely breakfast at camp, take a gentle hike through the forest in search of elephant, buffalo, giant forest hog and other forest animals. Enjoy a picnic lunch in a shady glade or perhaps a swim in a natural river pool. Your days at Kitich Camp are meant for relaxing! Overnight at Kitich.

Friday September 22 – Relax in the tall shady glade of Kitich Camp, explore the river banks, watch butterflies and birds and simply unwind in the wilderness of this isolated area. Overnight at Kitich Camp.

Saturday September 23 – A private charter flight takes you to Ol Malo for your last three days. Enjoy the hospitality of Colin and Rocky Francombe at this beautiful private house set on the edge of a cliff in the dry Northern District of Kenya. Overnight at Ol Malo.

Sunday September 24 – Visit a Samburu village and enjoy an introduction to the fascinating culture of this nomadic tribe. Enjoy a relaxing lunch at the swimming pool, take a game walk through the arid landscape and try a night in the waterhole hide if you would like an adventure. Overnight at Ol Malo.

Monday September 25 – Game drive in search of greater kudu, giraffe, lion and leopard or simply watch the animals as they gather at the waterhole below your cottage. Overnight at Ol Malo.

Tuesday September 26 – A private charter flight takes you back to Nairobi where you transfer to Macushla House in the Karen district of this city. Relax around the pool at this delightful small hotel or ask the hotel to arrange for a taxi to take you to the Karen Blixen museum, Utamuduni Shopping Centre or perhaps the Giraffe Manor, all of which are close to Macushla House. Overnight at Macushla House.

Wednesday September 27 - Breakfast at Macushla House before your transfer to the international airport for your departure flight. Please plan to be at the airport two hours before your flight departure time.

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The Sterchi Safari

Saturday December 4-Breakfast at the lodge. Morning drive via the famous Rift Valley escarpment to the shores of Lake Naivasha. Lunch at the club. Afternoon boat trip to Crescent Island for a nature walk. Dinner and overnight at Lake Naivasha Country Club.

Sunday December 5-Breakfast at the lodge. Morning drive through the Great Rift Valley to the Masai Mara National Reserve. Lunch at Mara Simba Lodge. Afternoon game drive. Dinner and overnight at Mara Simba Lodge.

Monday December 6-Early morning game drive before returning to the lodge for breakfast. Morning game drive. Lunch at the lodge. Afternoon game drive. Dinner and overnight at Mara Simba Lodge.

Tuesday December 7-Breakfast at the Mara Simba Lodge. Morning drive to Rekeru, arriving in time for lunch. Afternoon game drive or game walk, dinner and overnight at Rekeru.

Wednesday December 8-Depending upon your choice, enjoy Rekeru with game drives,

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game walks and cultural visits throughout the day. Whilst your host will make suggestions, your day is arranged to suit you.

Thursday December 9-Breakfast at Rehero before a leisurely game drive to the Ngegerende Airstrip for your 30 minute flight to Nairobi. Arrival at Wilson airport at approximately 12.15 noon. On arrival, met and transferred to the Hilton Hotel. Rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight at the Hilton Hotel.

Friday December 10-Breakfast at the hotel. Taxi transfers arranged by yourselves for the international return flights. You should count on 30-45 minutes to get to JKIA Airport and most international flights require a two-hour check-in period.

Hornbill Safari Itinerary February 14-23, 2001

A bird watcher's dream safari! This safari was designed to take in the best of Kenya's birding areas.

Covering swamps, savannah plains, lakes, forests and the ocean, this safari provided a chance to visit most of the richest birding areas of the country, while also giving a chance to spot the bigger wildlife as well.

Good quality, comfortable lodges and hotels were used as accommodation, allowing relaxing evenings after days spent in search of the smaller, rarer birds.

If you are bird watching fan, then this safari is for you!

Wednesday February 14 - Arrive at the Nairobi International Airport at 20.55. Met by your driver and the representative who will transfer you to the Hilton Hotel in downtown Nairobi. This transfer takes around 20-30 minutes. Your reservation at the Hilton has been booked directly by yourself.

Thursday February 15 - After an early breakfast, your driver/guide will collect you from the Hilton Hotel at 08.00. You will drive via Namanga to the Amboseli National Park at the foot of Mt. Kilimanjaro. Check into the lodge, before lunch at the lodge. Enjoy an afternoon game drive through this park, in search of the elephant and the numerous water birds attracted by the permanent water in the Amboseli swamp, before dinner and overnight at Amboseli Serena Lodge.

Friday February 16 - Breakfast at the lodge. A morning drive will take you via the famous Rift Valley escarpment to the shores of Lake Naivasha. Keep an eye out for birds of prey, especially the newly re-introduced Lammergeyer Vulture, using the thermals to seek their prey. Lunch at the club. Enjoy an afternoon boat trip to Crescent Island for a nature walk. Dinner and overnight at Lake Naivasha Country Club.

Saturday February 17 – Breakfast at the Club. A short morning drive to the Lake Nakuru National Park with a game drive enroute to the Lodge. Lunch at Lake Nakuru Lodge. Spend the afternoon watching the flamingos, herons, storks and other water birds that inhabit this beautiful lake. Many larger animals are also found here, in particular the rhino and lion. Dinner and overnight at Lake Nakuru Lodge.

Sunday February 18 – Breakfast at the Lodge. This morning drive takes you further up the Great Rift Valley to the world famous Masai Mara National Reserve. Game drive through the park on your way to the Mara Simba Lodge. Lunch at the Lodge. Buzzards, vultures, sunbirds, storks, hawks, eagles, elephant, lion, buffalo...you will be sure of spotting something in every corner of this rich ecosystem. Spend the afternoon exploring the Mara before dinner and overnight at Mara Simba Lodge.

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Monday February 19 – An early morning rise for a dawn game drive before returning to the Lodge for breakfast. Spend the morning exploring, lunch at the Lodge and then out once more to track down more birds and animals. Dinner and overnight at Mara Simba Lodge.

Tuesday February 20 – Breakfast at the Lodge. A morning drive to Nairobi and drop off at Wilson Airport to catch the 12.00 flight to Malindi. Met at the Malindi Airport and transferred to Hemingway's Hotel. Overnight at Hemingway's.

Wednesday-Thursday February 21-22 – At Hemingway's Hotel. Spend the days relaxing, or exploring the Arabuko-Sokoke Forest, or perhaps enjoy a sundowner cruise on Mida Creek. Visit Gede Ruins or go snorkelling in the Marine Park. In Watamu you may do as little or as much as you please.

Friday February 23 – Spend the day relaxing at Hemingway's before your 17.45 transfer to the Malindi Airport to catch the 18.45 Air Kenya flight to Nairobi. Arrive at 20.00. On arrival at Wilson Airport, met and transferred to the JKI Airport for your international departure flight.

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The Desourdy Safari

Masai Safari Itinerary September 12 – 29, 2000

Designed for a young, highly active couple, this trip takes you around the country, while adventure camping, hiking and game viewing.

Using public campsites, with a trained safari camping crew, this trip explores areas well away from the usual safari circuits. Covering dry, arid plains, rolling savannahs, rain forests and mountains, this safari goes to most of the different ecosystems that Kenya offers.

A wonderful exploration of the entire country, this safari is perfect any who don't mind a little 'bush adventure' on their vacation.

Tuesday September 12 - On arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, you'll be met and transferred to the Hilton Hotel. Your driver/guide will let you know what time he will meet you the next day to start your safari. Overnight at the Hilton Hotel.

Wednesday September 13 - Breakfast at the hotel. Morning meet your driver / guides and camp staff. Your truck is already packed to depart via the city center for Sagana, a campsite by the Tana River in the valleys of Mount Kenya. Set up camp in time for a light lunch and then spend the afternoon exploring this area. Safari briefing by the campfire, before dinner and overnight.

Thursday September 14 - Break camp after breakfast and depart for Samburu driving north over the western shoulder of Mount Kenya, through the farming lands of the Kikuyu people. Drive on to the hot dry plains of the Northern Frontier District to Samburu National Reserve. Set up camp by the Uaso Nyiro river that provides a little oasis of water for the animals in this dry area. Lunch dinner and overnight.

Friday September 15 - Spend the full day exploring this fabulous reserve with its unique species of wild life such as Somali Ostrich, Reticulated Giraffe, Grevy's Zebra, Beisa Oryx to name a few. Breakfast, lunch, dinner and overnight in camp.

Saturday September 16 - An early start, driving west through typical Samburu country into the Rift Valley, to the fresh water lake Baringo. Picnic lunch enroute. Arrive and set up camp in a Tortillis Acacia Glade. In the late afternoon take a bird walk along the cliffs that provide stunning views of the lake. Dinner and overnight in Camp.

Sunday September 17 - After an early breakfast take a boat ride on the lake, with good chances of seeing hippo, crocodile, and fish eagles hunting. After lunch a free afternoon to relax by the lake or for those who wish a walk to the local fishing village. Dinner and overnight in camp.

Monday September 18 - Early breakfast. Depart for Mt. Elgon, via the Kerio Valley, providing spectacular scenery of the rich highlands farming area. Arrive at Mt. Elgon, a national park

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famous for its caves that are frequented by elephant. Set up camp in the lush green campsite in this tropical mist forest. Dinner and overnight.

Tuesday September 19 - Awake at first light and after a cup of coffee depart for Saiwa Swamps in a nearby reserve to do a walking safari in search of the famous Sitatunga antelope with its webbed feet. Return to camp at Mt. Elgon for a late breakfast. Spend the rest of the morning enjoying your beautiful surroundings in camp. After lunch explore the caves where the elephants feed. Dinner and overnight in camp.

Wednesday September 20 - After breakfast depart for Kakamega market to re-supply on fresh vegetables and then continue into the Kakamega Tropical Rain Forest. Set up camp and have lunch before going on a guided nature walk of the forest. Dinner and overnight in camp.

Thursday September 21 - After an early breakfast depart south for Masai Mara via the tea growing highlands with a picnic lunch enroute. Arrive in the late afternoon, dinner and overnight at our campsite in Masai Mara.

Friday September 22 - Spend the full day exploring this fabulous game reserve with its numerous species of African game in the famous Serengeti ecosystem. A visit to a Masai manyatta (village) provides an incredible cultural experience. Breakfast, lunch, dinner and overnight in camp.

Saturday September 23 - Again spend the full day exploring this fabulous game reserve. An afternoon game walk provides a little variation to the usual game drive. Breakfast, lunch, dinner and overnight in camp.

Sunday September 24 - Depart after breakfast for Lake Naivasha in the Rift Valley. Arrive in time for lunch before a visit to the conservation site of Elsamere and a late afternoon boat trip on the lake. Dinner and overnight at the camp.

Monday September 25 - After breakfast, we take picnic lunches and make the long drive to Tsavo East National Park. We will camp in a forest glade or by the river. Dinner and overnight at Tsavo East Camp.

Tuesday-Wednesday September 26-27 – Days spent exploring this beautiful park where the game is still shy due to lack of exposure to tourists. All meals and overnight at Tsavo East Camp.

Thursday September 28 – After breakfast, drive back to Nairobi to the Oriental Palace Hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Friday September 29 – Transfer to the airport for your international departure flight.

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The Haley Safari

Masai Safari Itinerary July 14 – August 2, 2001

This couple was fascinated by African cultures; this itinerary was designed to offer a range of cultural experiences as well as wildlife viewing, for their honeymoon adventure.

Adventure camping with your own, private camping team provides a flexible and easily modified safari with lots of scope for cultural introductions to many of the tribes in Kenya.

Visiting the Masai, Njemps, Kikuyu, Samburu and Pokot tribes, this trip is perfect for those who wish to meet the people of a country and learn about the traditions and experiences of those who truly live in the wilderness of Africa.

*As you are on a camping safari, with only your final two nights confirmed at a permanent camp, you are not tied to the itinerary below. Should you wish to spend a longer or shorter period in one of the areas you visit, you may do so. Simply liaise with your camp crew and driver so that they may advise the distances and road conditions and you may then alter the trip to suit you.

Saturday July 14 – Arrive into Jomo Kenyatta Airport on the KLM 565 flight at 20.15. Met at the airport by the Eco-resorts representative and transferred to Macushla House in the Langata area of Nairobi for over night.

Sunday July 15 – After a good night's rest, enjoy breakfast at Macushla House before your camping team and vehicle collect you at 10.00am. Should you wish to purchase wine or beer for your trip, you may stop at a supermarket along the way.

A leisurely drive today over the Rift Valley Escarpment and into the Rift Valley itself. Drive past Mount Longonot and the blue waters of Lake Naivasha, to the Lake Nakuru National Park. Enjoy a picnic lunch and then head off on a game drive in this small but rich national park while your camping crew set up your adventure campsite. Dinner and overnight at the campsite.

Monday July 16 – A full day exploring the Lake Nakuru National Park. Famous for its bird life, Lake Nakuru also has a large population of lion and leopard and an excellent rhino sanctuary. All meals and overnight at the camp.

Tuesday July 17 – Pack up camp and drive further north into the more arid area of the Rift Valley, to the fresh water lake of Baringo. Set up camp here and enjoy an afternoon nature walk along the cliff tops, searching for eagles, antelope, giraffe and numerous other small game. Overnight at the campsite.

Wednesday July 18 – Today spend the day with the Njemps tribe of Lake Baringo. These fishermen will introduce you to their culture and traditions as you explore the lakeshore area.

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Enjoy a boat ride on the lake today, and perhaps even try your hand at traditional fishing!
Overnight at the camp.

Thursday July 19 – Leaving the Rift Valley behind, you head into the fertile farmlands of Kenya's western district. You'll drive through Kitale and arrive at the foot of Mount Elgon, home of the salt mining elephant. Set up camp in a forest glade inside this lovely park and watch the Colobus monkeys as they bounce around the tree canopy. Overnight at the camp.

Friday – Saturday July 20-21 – Spend two full days in this little visited park. With Kenya Wildlife Service rangers to escort you, walk through the forest trails in search of monkeys, elephant, buffalo, leopard, waterbuck and many more. Explore the caves in which the elephant find their minerals and salts and perhaps try hiking towards the summit if feeling very fit! Overnight at the campsite.

Sunday July 22 – Leaving the mountain behind you, drive the short distance to the last remaining area of tropical rain forest in Kenya. Kakamega offers yet another unusual ecosystem in Kenya, with tall trees, numerous birds, butterflies, duikers, monkeys and small mammals. Stay at the campsite in the forest and enjoy walks through the area. Overnight at the campsite.

Monday July 23 – A full day exploring the Kakamega Forest. Visit the local markets and enjoy an introduction to the tribes and cultures of this area. Overnight at the campsite.

Tuesday July 24 – Leaving the rich farmlands and forest behind, today you drive down to the rolling plains of the Masai Mara and Loita Hills. Here you'll set up camp and enjoy an afternoon game drive in the area. Overnight at the campsite.

Wednesday – Friday July 25-27 – Spend these three days exploring the Loita Hills and the Masai Mara Reserve on foot and by vehicle. Spend time with local Masai tribes in the villages learning about their traditions and culture. Spot the wildebeest migration and catch sight of the predators that abound in this area. Overnight in the campsites.

Saturday July 28 – Today you'll turn back south and re-enter the Rift Valley, arriving at Lake Naivasha in time for a late lunch. Relax at your campsite or spend the afternoon exploring Hell's Gate National Park. Overnight at the campsite.

Sunday July 29 – Leaving Lake Naivasha early, you head up the Rift Escarpment over towards the Aberdare Mountains and Mount Kenya. Driving through these undulating hills and craggy mountains, you approach the Laikipia Plateau and the Samburu area. You'll set up camp today in Samburu, famous for its Grevy's zebra, reticulated giraffe, Gerenuk, Oryx and other dry land species. Overnight at the campsite.

Monday July 30 – A full day exploring this rich but arid area. Follow the river as it meanders through the rough scrub and rocky outcrops and keep your eyes peeled for the surprisingly abundant wildlife. Overnight at the campsite.

Tuesday July 31 – Today you leave Samburu behind and head to the old settler town of Nanyuki, near Mount Kenya. Close by you'll find the permanent tented camp of Sweetwater's with its game sanctuary and chimpanzee center. Check-in to Sweetwater's where you will spend your last two nights being spoiled at this excellent camp. Your camp crew are nearby

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at the campsite and will still be your escorts and guides whenever needed. Overnight at Sweetwater's.

Wednesday August 1 – Spend a full day exploring the game sanctuary and chimpanzee center. All meals and overnight at Sweetwater's.

Thursday August 2 – After breakfast, head slowly back to Nairobi through the Kikuyu highlands; your guide will tell you about the local culture as you go. Arrive back in Nairobi and then transferred at the Jomo Kenyatta Airport in the evening to catch the KLM 566 flight departing at 22.40.

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The Johnston Safari

Hornbill Safari Itinerary July 10-25, 2001

This trip was created for an active couple that wished to walk and hike as much as possible. Visiting two of the best-known game parks in Kenya, the Masai Mara and Amboseli, the safari also visited several lesser-known areas in the Rift Valley and western Kenya.

Adventure camping with a trained safari crew gave freedom of movement and no set schedule. Visits to reserves allowed plenty of walking and hiking opportunities with local guides to introduce the flora and fauna of the area.

This safari itinerary is an excellent choice for those who prefer to be active and like to explore on foot.

Tuesday July 10 – Arrive into Nairobi at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport at 20.15pm. You will be met and collected by your Eco-resorts representative immediately after clearing customs. You'll be briefed on your camping safari by your representative on the way to your Nairobi Hotel, the Panafric Hotel. Check in to the hotel and enjoy a good night's sleep. Dinner is not included.

If you have belongings that you wish stored until your departure, please give them to the Eco-resorts representative at this time.

Wednesday July 11 – Have breakfast at the hotel; your camping team will meet you at 09.00. Your driver/guide and camp team will introduce themselves, load up your belongings and you'll head out on your safari. As we have discussed, your final itinerary may change depending upon how much you like each location. However, we recommend the following:

Drive to the Amboseli National Park, set up camp and game drive in the afternoon. Dinner and overnight at the campsite.

Thursday July 12 – Game driving and camping in Amboseli.

Friday July 13 – An early start in the morning takes you back past Nairobi to the Lake Nakuru National Park. Set up camp here and then enjoy an evening game drive searching for lion, leopard and rhino. Overnight at the campsite.

Saturday July 14 – Today leave the Rift Valley behind you as you drive up through the west of Kenya to the Mount Elgon National Park. Set up camp and enjoy an evening game drive. Overnight at the campsite.

Sunday July 15 – With a ranger for protection, visit the elephant caves and enjoy walking through the forest in this stunning mountain park. Keep an eye out for Colobus monkeys. Overnight at the campsite.

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Monday July 16 – Leave Mount Elgon and head across to the last remaining true rain forest in Kenya, Kakamega. Set up camp here and spend the day exploring the forest on foot. Superb bird life, butterflies, duikers and monkeys are all to be found here.

Tuesday July 17 – Enjoy a day relaxing at your campsite and walking through the forest with your guide. Overnight at the campsite.

Wednesday July 18 – Drive down to the ecosystem of the Masai Mara and the Loita Hills. Here you'll set up camp in the little explored Loita Hills and enjoy game drives, game walks and village visits as you please. Overnight in the campsites.

Thursday-Friday July 19-20 – In the Loita Hills.

Saturday July 21 – Enter the Mara itself today and enjoy game drives inside this spectacular area. Look out for the wildebeest migration and the predators that follow it around Kenya and Tanzania. Overnight in the Mara reserve campsite.

Sunday July 22 – Spend a full day here exploring the Mara Reserve. Overnight in the Mara.

Monday July 23 – Leaving the Mara behind, you'll head down into the Rift Valley once more, this time stopping at Lake Naivasha for your last night camping. Explore Hell's Gate National Park on foot and overnight at the campsite.

Tuesday July 24 – Head back to Nairobi in the morning, with the afternoon spent at the Animal Orphanage or Elephant Orphanage as you decide. Drop off at the Panafric Hotel in Nairobi. Overnight at the Panafric. Dinner is an extra charge.

Wednesday July 25 – An early start today as your driver collects you at 05.30 in the morning for your transfer to the Jomo Kenyatta Airport to check-in for the 07.55 flight to Zanzibar.

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The King Family Safari

Masai Safari Itinerary March 11-24, 2001

This safari was designed for a young, active family wanting to get off the beaten track in search of adventure.

Adventure camping allows complete freedom of travel as the camp crew sets up camp wherever you go. The chef creates excellent meals and your local guides provide a superb introduction to the animals, birds and plants of each area that you visit.

Comfortable igloo tents with thick mattresses, traditional short drop safari toilets and bucket showers provide more comforts than the 'boy-scout' camping! Your game drives take place in 4x4 vehicles, with expert driver/guides.

This safari is perfect for those with adventure in their hearts, yet enjoy the comforts of the Coast after the safari!

Sunday March 11 – Arrive at the Nairobi International Airport at 10.00 on the BA 2069. After clearing immigration and customs, you will be met by your driver/guide and representative. Look for the board with your name. You will head out of Nairobi and drive to the Sagana campsite near Mount Kenya. Spend the afternoon relaxing and exploring the area. Overnight at Sagana Campsite.

Monday March 12– After breakfast, drive down through the Rift Valley to Lake Nakuru. This small national park is surprisingly rich in wildlife and offers superb rhino, leopard and lion spotting opportunities. Overnight at your campsite.

Tuesday March 13– After breakfast, drive up over the Mau Escarpment and head toward the Masai Mara and the Loita Hills. Set up your first campsite and spend the afternoon in the Masai Mara Reserve, exploring this wonderful savannah eco-system. Overnight at the campsite.

Wednesday – Thursday March 14-15 – Spend this day walking in the Loita Hills, following your local Masai guide through the grasslands in search of the smaller game animals while learning about Masai culture from your guide. Your vehicle and driver/guide follows along with supplies and is available for a leg resting period! Overnight in the Loita Hills.

Friday March 16 – Head down into the Mara Reserve itself for your last full day, with game drives along the rivers and over the undulating hills. Keep an eye out for elephant, lion, cheetah, hyena and much more. Overnight in the Mara Reserve campsite.

Saturday March 17– Spend the morning exploring the reserve and then head to Nairobi in the early afternoon in time to catch your Kenya Airways flight from Jomo Kenyatta Airport to Malindi. The flight, KQ 642, departs at 18.30 and arrives at Malindi at 19.45. Your taxi driver will be there to meet you and will transfer you to the Aquarius Hotel for the remainder of your holiday.

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Saturday March 24– Collected by your taxi driver from the Aquarius Hotel at 11.45am. You will check into the Malindi Airport at 12.15, to catch the Kenya Airways flight, KQ 641, departing at 13.15, arriving in Nairobi at 14.45.

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The Sugden Safari

Masai Safari Itinerary July 14-August 1, 2001

A beach and bush combination for the budget traveler. Created for two young schoolteachers, this safari covers three of the classic safari destinations, Samburu, the Rift Valley and the Masai Mara, before finishing with a relaxing stop on the Indian Ocean.

Using simple, clean, permanent camps and lodges, with a delightful small beach resort at the end, this safari offered a wonderful introduction to animals, plants and landscapes of East Africa while keeping the costs to a minimum.

This itinerary is a wonderful introduction to the wilderness of Africa and is perfect for anyone who needs to watch their budget, but still requires safety and comfort on the vacation.

Saturday July 14 – Arrive at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport at 15.00. Met by the Eco-resorts representative and transferred to Macushla House. Overnight at Macushla House.

Sunday July 15 - After breakfast at Macushla House, you will be collected at 07.30am and taken to join the group safari departure. Leave Nairobi, passing through the rich agricultural farmland on the slopes of Mountain Kenya to the mainly dry scrubland and open savannah plains of Samburu Game Reserve. Here the Ewaso Nyiro River supports a wide variety of game, among them elephant, buffalo, cheetah, leopard, lion, grevvy's zebra, reticulated giraffe, oryx and the long necked gerenuk. Accommodation in our semi-permanent campsite beautifully set on the edge of the river, or pitch tents under a canopy of trees.

Monday July 16 - Full day spent game viewing in the park; a dip in Buffalo Springs during the hot afternoon may be refreshing!

Tuesday July 17 - Leaving Samburu in the early morning, you'll make a scenic drive to the west across the Lerochi Plateau, (lunch enroute) and later descend to the floor of the Great Rift Valley, arriving at Lake Baringo in the afternoon. This is a fresh water lake, which supports a great variety of birds as well as hippos and crocodiles. Indeed, the Lake is reputed to be the bird-watching centre of Kenya.

Wednesday July 18 - Early in the morning, head south via Lake Bogoria, which is a shallow soda lake with a beautiful scenery and also home to a sizeable number of flamingos and other species of birds. The highlight, however, is the boiling hot springs and geysers, which also contribute to the beauty of the lake.

After lunch, we proceed to Lake Nakuru in the south to another shallow soda lake, which has been described as "an ornithologists paradise and one of the world's most magnificent sights". Here one has an opportunity to see up to two million flamingos besides tens of thousands of other birds if lucky. Lake Nakuru also has a rhino sanctuary and also harbors lions, warthogs, waterbucks, buffaloes, hippo and many other animals. Dinner and overnight in a campsite outside town.

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Thursday July 19 - Head further south to Narok, camping in our permanent campsite on the Talek River, which is at the edge of the Masai Mara. Here we have stand-up tents with beds for use if available; otherwise we pitch tents. Showers are available in the camp and meals are served in the dining mess or in the open.

Friday – Saturday July 20-21 - From the base camp, you'll explore the Masai Mara region, packed with the elephant, zebra, rhino and all kinds of game throughout the year with the spectacular wildebeest migration from Serengeti occurring mainly in July and August.

Being at Masai Mara is "as if you found yourself in the New York of the natural world", according to some authorities. Indeed, you have the best opportunity of seeing all the "Big Five" animals here. Masai cultural dancers will be at hand to entertain you on your last evening.

Sunday July 22 - We break camp and drive to Narok where Masai souvenirs can be bought, then proceed to Nairobi arriving in the afternoon. You will be collected by your Eco-resorts driver and transferred to the airport for your Kenya Airways flight to Malindi, which departs at 18.30. Arriving in Malindi at 19.45, you will be met and taken to the Barracuda Hotel in Watamu. Dinner and overnight at the Barracuda Inn.
